## Can I Mix Brake Fluid?

**Application:** All vehicles.

**Question:** Can I mix brake fluid?

**Answer:** **NO!** When servicing a brake system you **must always replace** the brake fluid using OE specified brake fluid. Replacing the fluid avoids contaminating the entire brake system. Mixing fluids or using petroleum based fluids will destroy seals and gaskets throughout the entire brake system (see example), causing catastrophic brake failure. This can result in **vehicle damage and/or personal injury**.

**Note:** Mixing or using the wrong brake fluid **will void the warranty**. Always refer to manufacturer's specifications when selecting the proper brake fluid. Always use new fluid from an unopened container.
